ABOUT THE POSITION:

Lifeguard II - (Beach or Lake Lifeguard): Work as a lifeguard at either Cayucos Beach or Lopez Lake Recreation Area.

TYPICAL TASKS:

Lifeguard II - Daily responsibilities include: Supervision of visitor use at a County aquatic facility or designated swim area; enforcement of County policies and regulations; preventative lifeguarding; affecting rescues; providing basic first aid to the public; distribution of information regarding aquatics programs; aquatic site maintenance, and other related duties as assigned. In addition, Cayucos Beach Lifeguard may be scheduled to work as an instructor for the Junior Lifeguard Program.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Lifeguard II – Cayucos Beach Lifeguards must have United States Lifeguarding Association (USLA) Certification and American Red Cross Lifeguarding Certificate at the time of application; Lopez Lake Lifeguards must have American Red Cross Lifeguarding Certificate at the time of application; both positions require CPR for the Professional Rescuer—including infant, child, adult and two-man or bag valve mask (BVM)—and Title 22 Certifications completed prior to active duty (EMT certification can substitute for CPR for the Professional Rescuer and Title 22 requirements); a Social Security Card is required at the time of appointment. **NOTE:** Employees in these classifications are required to work irregular hours, holidays and weekends.

TESTING:

Lifeguard II – All lifeguard personnel must pass both a written and physical performance test.

PLEASE NOTE: New employees are required to complete INS Employment Eligibility Verification forms to certify citizenship or legal residency and authorization to work. These are temporary appointments without benefits or tenure. Must also pass County pre-employment medical exam. All prospective employees must submit to and pass screening under Public Resources Code Section 5164 in regards to criminal offenses.

NOTIFICATION:

Appointment may be made at either level depending on qualifications of the applicant and needs of the department.

SELECTION PROCESS:

Applicants will be notified by mail or phone if they are to be interviewed for the available positions. Those applicants not selected for interview will be notified by mail. Requests for special accommodation pursuant to the American Disabilities Act must be made in advance. Apply at the County Personnel Office, 1035 Palm Street, Room 384, San Luis Obispo, CA 93408. A REASONABLE EFFORT WILL BE MADE TO ACCOMMODATE THE NEEDS OF THE DISABLED AND THE RELIGIOUS NEEDS OF AN APPLICANT. IF YOU REQUIRE SPECIAL ARRANGEMENTS TO PARTICIPATE IN THE RECRUITMENT PROCESS, YOU MUST INFORM THE COUNTY PERSONNEL DEPARTMENT IN WRITING OF THE TYPE AND EXTENT OF ACCOMMODATION NO LATER THAN THE FINAL FILING DEADLINE.
