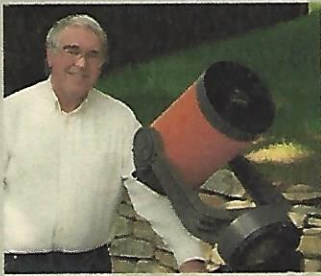




Star Gazing Star Party
